K.N. is a 24-year-old woman who presents to the family practice clinic complaining of sudden urgency to urinate, back pain, frequent urination, and pain with urination. Symptoms began approximately 48 hours ago.

She awoke from sleep with urgency and suprapubic discomfort 2 nights ago.

Her urine now has a strong odor and a cloudy appearance. She has an allergy to Bactrim.

- 1. What are some appropriate questions to ask the patient?
- 2. What are three differential diagnoses for the patient?
- 3. What physical examination would you perform?
- 4. What diagnostics would you include?
- 5. Create an evidenced-based plan of care. Include pharmacological and non-pharmacological treatments.

Urine dipstick results:

Color, dark yellow, specific gravity 1.035, ph 5.5, protein (-), Ketones (-), Bilirubin (-), Trace blood, Leukoesterase (+), Nitrites (+), Urobilinogen (-)

Minimum: 250+- words

Content must be **substantive**, **qualitative** and **answer** the discussion board questions. Do not add sentences/paragraph which has no relevancy to your discussion board questions as listed above. **Do not re-ask the questions and reference list doesn't count for word count**.

All discussion (as listed above items, 1-5) items must be clearly identifiable – no tangling back and forth. Must meet all rubrics and must meet APA requirements!

A cover page includes Name, title, date, name of the professor. This applies to all assignments submitted, must meet APA requirements.

Must have minimum of **4 sources from these categories**:

- One from school library (must select one article from school library). Not obtained from "Medscape" or "Mayo Clinic" or any other site that provides health information (Very important to note!!!)
- 2. One from text book (Fred F. Ferri-Ferri's Clinical Advisor 2019-Elsevier (2019))
- 3. **Two** from EVIDENCE BASED PEER REVIEW SOURCE
- 4. As NPs, we must support use of evidence -based approaches to medicine. Websites such as:

APA 6th edition is the expectation and I do check references. Do not plagiarize. I also use a web-based plagiarism tool if I suspect work that is not original. If I have a high suspicion, I will use Turn It In account, which is then part of the national plagiarism database of thousands of documents. For this course, I expect a similarity level of 0%-10% or less.

You may be asked to submit your research journal/documents which you have used for reference.

A graduate student should be able to write cohesive sentences using standard English. Grammar, punctuation and APA rules should be followed. No dangling participles or split infinitives, ladies and gentlemen! Sloppy work will not be tolerated and will be returned with a grade of 0.

Be sure to spell-check and proofread your work before turning in the final product. Just because the rubric doesn't require me to assess a score, I will use my professional judgment.
